The adventure continues into the endless white horizon of the Uyuni Salt Flats, where reflective surfaces, cactus-covered islands, volcanic scenery, and vast open skies create one of the most surreal landscapes on Earth. Finally, the journey descends into the tropical lowlands of the Bolivian Amazon, where rivers, dense jungle, and untouched wilderness reveal an entirely different ecosystem filled with wildlife and natural beauty. Together, these three regions offer one of South America's most diverse travel experiences—combining culture, extreme landscapes, and deep nature immersion in a single journey.

From Andean City to Salt Desert and Amazon Jungle This multi-region journey is designed to showcase Bolivia's most iconic contrasts through carefully curated experiences across high-altitude cities, desert landscapes, and tropical rainforest environments. In La Paz, travelers explore local markets, colonial streets, cable car viewpoints, and cultural landmarks that reflect Bolivia's unique Andean identity. The journey continues to Uyuni, where 4x4 expeditions cross vast salt plains, visit Incahuasi Island, explore salt processing villages, and capture surreal reflections across endless white horizons. From the highlands, the experience moves into the Amazon region of Madidi National Park, where jungle trails, river navigation, and wildlife observation reveal one of the most biodiverse ecosystems on the planet. Each stage of the itinerary offers a completely different environment, creating a dynamic and unforgettable travel experience across Bolivia.

City Tour.

City Tour and Valley of the Moon A 4 hours city tour through La Paz, elected as one of the 7 wonder cities in the world. It is located in a valley at the foothills of the Andes Range, situated at 3,632m / 11942 ft. above sea level. The tour goes through the street markets rich in handicrafts, weavings and witchcraft items, followed by a visit to the colonial section of the city, San Francisco Church, Gold Museum, Murillo Square also visit to the viewpoint "Mirador de Killi Killi"; and the outdoor replica of Tiwanaku temple. Then descending to the more modern, southern part of La Paz to reach and visit the Valley of the Moon, where a clay mountain has been impressively shaped by erosion. Ride by cable car "Teleférico", it's a good choice to discover an excellent and beautiful view of La Paz. This is a must for every one!

Arrival and transfer to your hotel.This journey starts at 10.00 am, visit the train cemetery with remains of the locomotives of nineteenth and the beginning of twentieth centuries, then enter the great Uyuni Salt Flats visiting on the road Colchani town, to see a traditional salt processing plant, continue with a stop in Ojos de Agua (the eyes of water), a place where the underground water goes to the surface, in addition to observe the way of salt extraction; later, to Incahuasi Island where the famous giant Cactus are, lunch will be served in the middle of the Salt flats. Later, appreciating the breathtaking sunset at Uyuni Salt flats.Included: Picnic lunch in Uyuni Salt flatsOvernight at Hotel Palacio de Sal or similar.

Flight to La Paz with both transfers.* Chalalan and Madidi itineraries are subject to change according to visitors preferences. Transfer Airport - Hotel La Paz El Alto airport is currently the highest International airport in the world at 4,080m/13,115 ft. above sea level. Transfer from airport to hotel, via a short highway from which there is a nice view over the city of La Paz and nearby snow-capped mountains. Overnight at hotel Presidente or similar.
